## **Background:**

**First Baptist Church** is located at 347 N. Ripley Street in Montgomery, Alabama. The church is seeking a committed Christ follower, gifted in the areas of music and leadership to direct our music ministry. The Director of Music is directly accountable to the Board of Trustee of First Baptist Church for the satisfactory fulfillment all functions and responsibilities.

This person will provide a vision and establish direction for the musical future of our vibrant church congregation that will assist efforts to enlarge the church membership. This candidate should have a strong music background to include training and experience in conducting church choirs. The position requires the ability to lead and develop music programs that include a variety of music types: anthems, hymns, spirituals, and traditional gospel.

# **Church History:**

First Baptist Church was organized in 1866 and grew out of First Baptist Church, on Perry Street, where early parishioners worshipped as slaves. The church has a proud tradition as the home of the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc.; as the host church for the first baccalaureate service for State Normal School, now Alabama State University; and, as the place for civil rights activities including the Montgomery Bus Boycott in 1955 and the Freedom Riders in 1961. Under the leadership of nine pastors, the church ministers have been known worldwide for their outreach activities including noted ministers, Dr. Andrew Stokes, and Rev. Ralph Abernathy. The present edifice was built with bricks contributed by members who brought them each day and is affectionately known as the Brick-a-Day Church.
